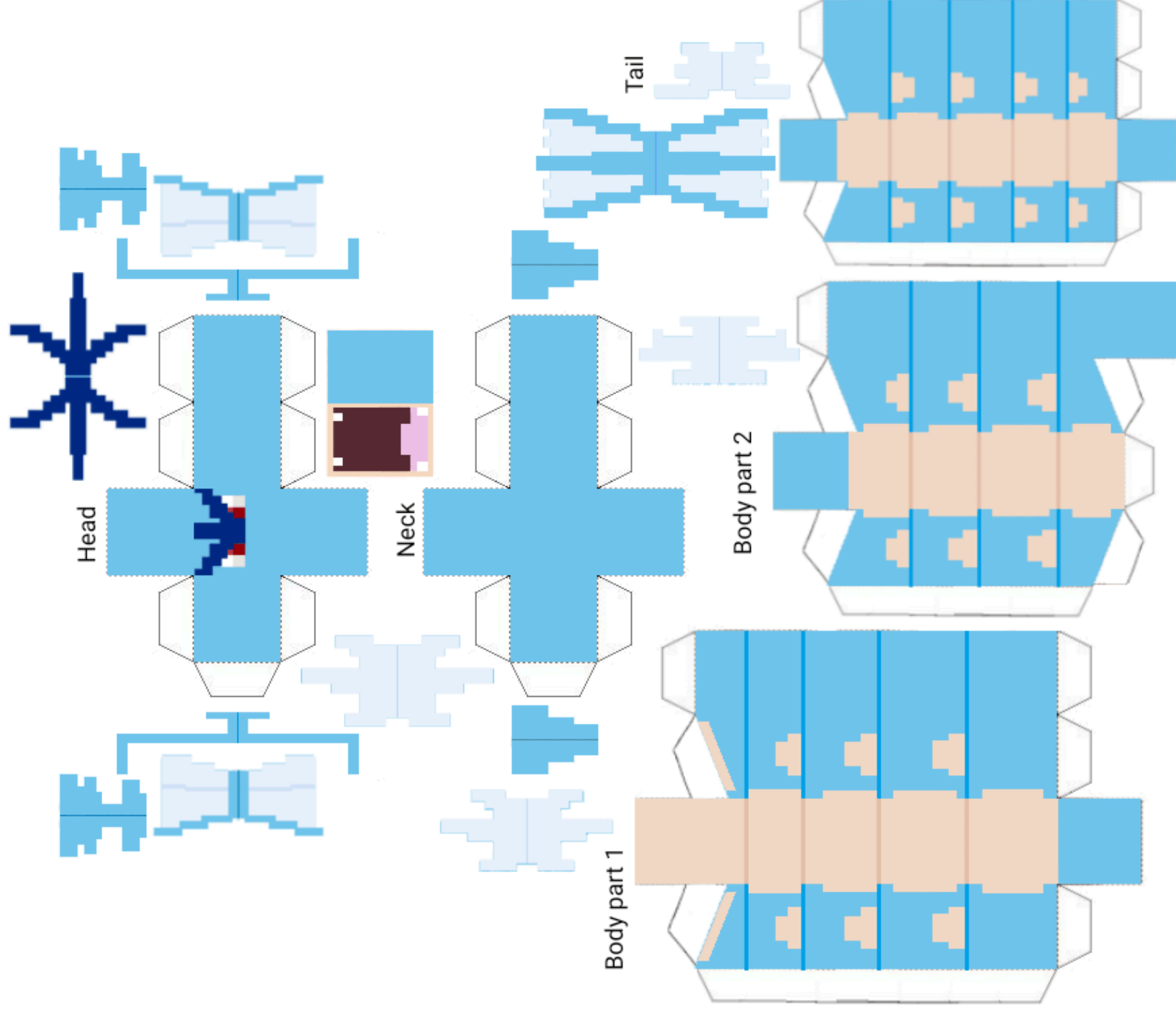

Step 1: Gather Materials

- Paper or cardstock (thicker paper works better for sturdy crafts)
- Scissors or craft knife
- Glue or double-sided tape
- Ruler
- Pencil or pen (for marking)
- Optional: Markers, colored pencils, or paint for customization

Step 2: Prepare the Template

Print the Template: If using an online template, print it on paper or directly onto cardstock.

Check the Size: Make sure the template fits your needs. Adjust the scale before printing if necessary.

Step 3: Cut Out the Pieces

- Use scissors or a craft knife to carefully cut out each shape from the template.
